## Barn Door Handle Installation Guidelines

Every successful installation begins with good planning and action. Do not wait until the last minute to order your Barn Door Handles for installation. From time to time stock replenishment may be in process and require a lead time. Make sure that all aspects of the product placement are considered and discussed to ensure that your Barn Door Handle installation will be a success!

Note that this installation document should not be considered a specific recommendation for your particular application. Federal Brace cannot provide installation guidelines to meet the particulars of every application. This document should be considered a help sheet that provides considerations about the general characteristics of a particular type of product and installation.

### Characteristics of the Barn Door Handle

The Barn Door Handle comes to you in the selected finish and includes your handle and fasteners. Two 0.18" straight holes are provided for fastening the handle to your specific application material.

#### Installation Considerations

Whenever installing Barn Door Handles make sure you are tying into a solid wood surface. You will want the

fasteners to have as much biting material as possible. Most standard doors have a solid wood edge but you should always consult the door manufacturer before starting the project.

#### Installation of the Barn Door Handle

1. Determine top flange placement using a tape measure and pencil. Mark a small horizontal line.

2. Use a tape measure to decide the center placement and mark a small vertical line.

3. Use a level or square to position the handle on your horizontal and vertical marks. Make reference marks as needed.

4. Holding the handle in place, mark the pilot hole locations with a pencil.

5. Using a drill with a drill bit smaller than the included fastener threads, drill out all the pilot holes. PRO TIP - Place a piece of tape on your drill bit to mark your drill depth.

6. Using included fasteners, attach the handle. Be sure not to over-tighten them.
